

Keys & Sword Annual Event

The Keys & Sword Event takes its name from the symbols for Saint Peter, the keys, and for Saint Paul, the sword.

The Keys & Sword Event of the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul was established in 2017 to promote a wider culture of financial support beyond the Cathedral Parish. The highpoint of this Keys & Sword effort is the festive dinner near to June 29th, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the patrons of the Cathedral Basilica. Financial support comes from those who attend the annual dinner, from direct donors and ads published in the Ad Book. It is possible to contribute to the Keys & Sword effort all throughout the year.

Formerly, a Keys and Sword Award was presented by the Cathedral Parish to acknowledge a member of the religious or civic community recognized for extraordinary commitment to the Gospel and selfless dedication to others.



Memorial to Venerable Cornelia Connelly and The Shrine of the Holy Child

Venerable Cornelia Connelly offers inspiration to all who seek the will of God in their vocations, especially those in difficult marriages and who have suffered the death of children.



On October 17, 2021, the Memorial to Venerable Cornelia Connelly and the Shrine of the Holy Child, located to the right of the main entrance of the Cathedral Basilica, was solemnly blessed.

Venerable Cornelia Connelly, born in Philadelphia (1809-1879), is the foundress of the Society of the Holy Child Jesus. All are encouraged to pray for the Beatification of Venerable Cornelia Connelly. Saint Camilla Battista Varani

Born April 9, 1458, Saint Camilla Battista Varani was the daughter of Duke Julius Caesar Varani of Camerino, Italy. As a young girl, Saint Camilla heard one particular Good Friday homily.

Contemplating this homily, she vowed to mourn the passion of Christ every Friday for the rest of her life. It was a difficult endeavor because of her vivacious personality and the distractions her aristocratic paternal household provided. Aided by God's grace and the support of her confessors, she persevered. As time passed, Saint Camilla grew in fervor and faith until she was able to accept her vocation. After struggling with both her inner self and her father, she willingly chose to consecrate her life to God. At age 23, Camilla officially joined the order of Poor Clares in Urbino, Italy, taking the religious name of Sr. Battista. Jesus repaid her generously by favoring her with mystical experiences, of which we find traces in her writings.

Throughout her life, Saint Camilla strived to identify herself with the sufferings of Jesus and His Passion. In her writings, Saint Camilla recounts experiencing the pains of the stigmata and the experience of Jesus appearing to her. Camilla Battista died in Camerino, Italy on May 31, 1524. In 1843, Pope Gregory XVI declared her Beatified. She was later Canonized October 17, 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI.

This is a big project with a projected cost of \$3,000,000.
